## 12. HEALTH

In 2006, there were 168 hospitals with 15,422 beds. 138 are private hospitals with 82.7% of beds and 30 are public with 17.3% of beds. 18 private hospitals included 3,385 beds for long stay. 137,026 were hospitalized. North Lebanon registered the patients' peak (25.7%). There were also 46 foreign patients.

### The Syndicate of Hospitals statistics in 2007

The data are related to 127 hospitals where Matn registered the peak (22.8%). With a total number of beds, Matn registered 24.6%. With 26,983 of total number of hospital staff, Matn registered 25.5%. The breakdown of hospitals staff shows 10,195 employees of which Matn registered 24.6%, 11,672 nurses of which Matn registered 25.6%, 185 Pharmacists of which Matn registered 18.9% and 4,931 doctors of which Matn registered 27.2%.

# Public spending on health services in 2007

Total public spending was 613 billion LBP in 2007. The Ministry of Health paid the highest amount (36.3%) and was followed by the National Security Social Fund (22.0%). This public spending dealt with hospitalization (64.8%), drugs (11.4%) and out-patients (23.8%).

# **Civil Defence Activities**

Activities decreased by 2.4% between 2006 and 2007. Fire extinction increased by 10.7%. In 2006, training missions were 385 with 21,101 trainees. There was an average of 55 trainees by training. In 2007, Maritime mission counted 823 which peaks were training (38.9%).




