23. PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

Engineers

There are 2,051 engineers registered in 2009 at the Orders of Architects an Engineers in Beirut and in Tripoli. These engineers are distributed as follows:



- Females: 20.5% of total engineers registered at the Order of Beirut.
















